Michael Eugene Porter was born in May 1947. He is entitled Father of Modern Business Strategy and infamous for his theory on Porter's five forces.

Dr Porter, the most cited scholar in Economics and Business, was also a researcher, author, strategic advisor, speaker, teacher and economist.

WHY IS HE SO IMPORTANT?

He began his journey by acing the field of aerospace engineering, Harvard University MBA, and PhD in Business Economics. In 2000, Harvard Business School and Harvard University jointly initialized Porter's Institute as the Strategy and Competitiveness research lab.

WHAT ARE HIS ACHIEVEMENTS?

Being an author of 125 articles and 19 books on

- Domestic and Global Healthcare
- US political competitiveness

Economics has made him sharpen his passion towards academics.

Further, winning literary awards, 24 honorary doctorates, national/state honors, a Lifetime Achievement Award and being entitled as a "University Professor by Harvard" were a few of his major milestones in life.




ENTREPRENEURSHIP CIRCLE
